You can be environmentally aware while enjoying a comfortable sleep by simply placing this product on your mattress.

Since people around the world are increasingly paying attention to being environmentally aware and to carbon neutrality, Archem is also actively making efforts as a urethane manufacturer by considering the application of this plant material to a variety of products in the future. Although regular urethane is manufactured by the reaction of petroleum-derived polyol with polyisocyanate, this product is manufactured by compounding petroleum-derived polyol with





palm-derived polyol. Although there is only a limited number of plant-derived industrial products available around the world, this product contributes to a carbon-neutral society by reducing effective CO2 emissions from manufacturing caused by incineration.

- Easy to place! Simply lay it on top of your usual bedding


